

English as a Foreign Language (EFL)



Full Time English is offered at Elementary, Pre Intermediate and Intermediate levels

What You Will Study: You will study all four Language Skills – **Listening, Reading, Speaking** and **Writing**.

You will also study British Studies, Study Skills and Business English.

Who the Courses are for: The course is designed for students wanting to improve their level of English. The aim is to increase the students' confidence in communicating in English, to focus on day-to-day language needs and the requirement of English for academic studies.

How You Will Study: You will attend regular classes with other students.

How you will be Assessed: Homework and Module tests. We can also help to arrange an IELTS examination for you at Bangor University.

Course Length: You can start at any time of year. There are 16 hours of tuition per week. Students can enter the UK on either a Tier 4 Student Visa or an Extended Student Visitor Visa (11 months or less). The International Office will be happy to advise you.

Entry Requirements: you will need a minimum level of English (Level B1)

Your Options after the Course: Progression to Upper Intermediate is possible, as too is the opportunity to enrol on a number of Full Time programmes where English support, where possible, is provided including: Academic study at Pre Degree or Degree level.

Cost: £4,500 (GBP) or 6-11 months study, pro rata

Accommodation: Catered £85 (GBP) per week or
Self Catered £65 (GBP) per week.

Summer English Courses are available for those wishing to prepare for their full time programme of study or for people wanting a study holiday. The Summer School includes in the price weekly trips to places of interest and has included trips to Liverpool football club, the Beatles museum, Chinatown, historic castles and lots more.
